| 18 | A. By September 1, 2016, the secretary of public |

C. As used in this section, "psychomotor skillsbased cardiopulmonary resuscitation training" means instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation that uses hands-on practice to support cognitive learning.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.--One hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the public education department for expenditure in fiscal year 2017 to fund instruction in psychomotor skills-based cardiopulmonary resuscitation and the use of an automated external defibrillator in schools pursuant to Section 1 of this act. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2017 shall revert to the general fund.

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
