16	SECTION 1. A new section of the Uniform Licensing Act is
17	enacted to read:
18	"[<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] EXPEDITED LICENSUREISSUANCE
19	A. A state agency, board or commission that issues
20	an occupational or professional license pursuant to Chapter 61,
21	Articles 2 through 34 NMSA 1978 shall, as soon as practicable
22	after a person files an application for a license accompanied
23	by the required fees:
24	(1) process the application; and
25	(2) issue a license to a qualified applicant
