11 RELATING TO HIGHER EDUCATION; DIRECTING THE SECRETARY OF HIGHER
12 EDUCATION TO ESTABLISH A CONSISTENT POLICY AND ARTICULATION
13 AGREEMENT REGARDING THE EVALUATION AND AWARD OF COLLEGE CREDIT
14 BASED ON MILITARY TRAINING.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

17 SECTION 1. TEMPORARY PROVISION--COLLEGE CREDIT FOR
18 MILITARY TRAINING--REPORTING.--The higher education department,
19 in coordination with the institutions of higher education in
20 New Mexico, shall study, create and implement a consistent
21 policy and develop a single articulation agreement for the
22 state, regarding the evaluation and award of academic credit
23 based on an active duty member of the United States military or
24 a veteran's military training and experience toward
25 associate's, bachelor's, master's and doctoral degrees. The
