11 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT DIVISION OF THE
12 DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION FOR HEALTH CARE AND
13 SENIOR SERVICES IN RIO ARRIBA COUNTY.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

16 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.--

17 A. Nine hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$950,000)
18 is appropriated from the general fund to the local government
19 division of the department of finance and administration for
20 expenditure in fiscal year 2017 to fund the following
21 operational expenses in Rio Arriba county:

22 (1) the expansion of senior programming to
23 include senior center services, including adult daycare;
24 personal care service management; case management; medication
25 management; diabetes monitoring and management; grief support;

1 immunization; fall prevention; and joint pain management and
2 prevention;

3 (2) provision of intensive case management for
4 substance abuse, incorporating enrollment and recovery support
5 for released inmates; transport to services; jail diversion;
6 vouchers for recovery support for substance abuse treatment;
7 and recovery support;

8 (3) formation of provider networks, including
9 development of a health information exchange for network
10 members;

11 (4) provision of services in county-owned
12 community centers; and

13 (5) infrastructure planning to enable the
14 incorporation of existing county-owned facilities into the
15 county's comprehensive health care system.

16 B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining
17 at the end of fiscal year 2017 shall revert to the general
18 fund.
