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AN ACT

RELATING TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT; CREATING A PROGRAM TO
ENCOURAGE SOLO-WORKER JOB CREATION AND INCREASE THE
COMMERCIAL REVENUE DERIVING FROM OUT-OF-STATE SOURCES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. SOLO-WORKER PROGRAM.--

A. As used in this section:

(1) "economic-base job" means a job in which
sixty percent or more of the revenue generated from the goods
or services produced derives from outside the state;

(2) "program agency" means a certified
business incubator, a community college or an organization
whose purpose is to create jobs and promote economic
development; and

(3) "solo worker" means a person who is
engaged in full-time employment and whose employer, if any,
does not supply the office space or amenities used to perform
the person's work.

B. The "solo-worker program" is created in the
economic development department. The purpose of the solo-
worker program is to improve the state's rural and urban
economies by creating and sustaining economic-base jobs and
expanding businesses owned and operated by solo workers
engaged in economic-base jobs.

1 C. To carry out the purpose of the solo-worker
2 program, the department shall provide matching funding, if
3 other funds become available, to program agencies for
4 advancing initiatives that:

5 (1) create opportunities for New Mexico
6 residents to become solo workers engaged in economic-base
7 jobs;

8 (2) support the continued employment and
9 business expansion of existing solo workers engaged in
10 economic-base jobs;

11 (3) recruit from outside of the state solo
12 workers engaged in economic-base jobs; and

13 (4) make the state and its local communities
14 more competitive for creating, attracting and retaining solo-
15 worker jobs. _____

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
