RELATING TO PUBLIC ASSISTANCE; REQUIRING THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO PROVIDE AN ANNUAL REPORT ON THE DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES MEDICAID HOME- AND COMMUNITY-BASED WAIVER

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO: SECTION 1. DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES -- MEDICAID HOME- AND COMMUNITY-BASED SUPPORTS AND SERVICES--ANNUAL **REPORT WITH FIVE-YEAR COST PROJECTIONS.--**

By October 1, 2016 and by October 1 of each Α. year thereafter, the department of health shall provide a report to the legislative finance committee and the legislative health and human services committee on the supports and services provided pursuant to the developmental disabilities medicaid home- and community-based waiver The report shall include:

for each of the five most recent state (1)fiscal years, the number of individuals who:

(a) were served in the developmental disabilities medicaid home- and community-based waiver

received developmental disabilities (b) medicaid home- and community-based waiver services for the 24 25 first time that year based on an approved initial service SB 36

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1 plan, including information on the average length of time 2 that individuals for whom services were newly approved during 3 the fiscal year had awaited allocation on the developmental disabilities medicaid home- and community-based waiver 4 5 waiting list before plan approval; (c) were awaiting allocation at the end 6 of the fiscal year; 7 8 (d) were added to the waiting list, sorted by status category; and 9 (e) were removed from the waiting list 10 due to reasons other than allocation to the developmental 11 disabilities medicaid home- and community-based waiver 12 program services; 13 for each of the five most recent state (2)14 fiscal years, the amount of state funds, if any, that the 15 legislature has appropriated that: 16 (a) exceeds the previous state fiscal 17 year's allocation of state funds for the purpose of 18 increasing the number of individuals served in the 19 developmental disabilities medicaid home- and community-based 20 waiver program for each state fiscal year; and 21 (b) has reverted at the end of the 22 state fiscal year; 23 for each of the five most recent state (3) 24 fiscal years, the amount of state and federal funds expended 25 SB 36 Page 2

1 for developmental disabilities medicaid home- and 2 community-based waiver program services; 3 (4) a projection of the number of registrants who will be in awaiting allocation status at the 4 5 end of each of the upcoming five state fiscal years, based on: 6 historical data on the annual (a) 7 average number of registrations for the developmental 8 disabilities waiver that were confirmed to meet the 9 eligibility definition through match determination and moved 10 to awaiting allocation status; and 11 (b) other relevant program data; and 12 a projection of the amount of additional (5) 13 state funding required so that by the end of the upcoming 14 five-year period, individuals on the waiting list awaiting 15 allocation have a registration date not more than three years 16 earlier than the date of the end of that five-year period. 17 B. As used in this section: 18 (1) "awaiting allocation" means that an 19 individual on the waiting list for the developmental 20 disabilities medicaid home- and community-based waiver 21 program has been determined by the department of health 22 through match determination to meet the eligibility 23 definition for the program; 24 "match determination" means the process (2) 25
