16	provided in Subsection B, C or D of this section.
17	B. Off-highway motor vehicles may cross streets or
18	highways, except limited access highways or freeways, if the
19	crossings are made after coming to a complete stop prior to
20	entering the roadway. Off-highway motor vehicles shall yield
21	the right of way to oncoming traffic and shall begin a
22	crossing only when it can be executed safely and then cross
23	in the most direct manner as close to a perpendicular angle
24	as possible.
