#### SUMMARY

Synopsis of HJC Amendment

The House Judiciary Committee amendment specifies that the New Mexico Attorney General and New Mexico Cultural Affairs Department are to work with tribal and community leaders to review the Cultural Properties Act.

#### Synopsis of Original Bill

HJM 1 resolves that, pursuant to federal and state law and policy, the attorney general and cultural affairs department work with tribal and community leaders to review the Cultural Properties Act and make recommendations about enhanced protection of cultural items, including preventing misappropriation of cultural items, theft, wrongful sale, and alienation of cultural items.

## FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

Neither responding agency estimated a potential fiscal impact.

# SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

DCA questions if the memorial intends to include the issue of misrepresentation of contemporary non-Native American made products as Native American made. If so, the review process may wish to consider avenues to address this problem in addition to the Cultural Properties Act, due to the constraints and focus of that Act as it is directed towards objects of cultural patrimony, burials, public lands and public agencies.
