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14	WHEREAS, one in five New Mexicans serves as a family
15	caregiver during any given year; and
16	WHEREAS, each year, an estimated four hundred nineteen
17	thousand adults in the state provide an estimated two hundred
18	fifty-seven million hours of unpaid family caregiving at an
19	estimated value of over three billion one hundred million
20	dollars (\$3,100,000,000); and
21	WHEREAS, the governor and the aging and long-term services
22	department released the New Mexico State Plan for Family
23	Caregivers in 2015, which identifies unpaid lay caregiver
24	issues and needs; and
25	WHEREAS, AARP New Mexico has been a leader in addressing

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1 lay caregiver issues and needs and is bringing volunteers and partners together to raise awareness and develop specific 2 3 recommendations; and WHEREAS, in 2015, the legislature addressed a family 4 5 caregiver issue of concern and enacted legislation to allow for the designation and training of lay caregivers to provide care 6 7 to patients after discharge; and WHEREAS, the New Mexico State Plan for Family Caregivers 8 9 provides recommendations for future action; and WHEREAS, unpaid lay caregivers need to be recognized for 10 their work; 11 12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that February 12, 2016 be commemorated as "I 13 Heart Caregivers Day" in the senate; and 14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be 15 transmitted to the AARP New Mexico state office and the 16 secretary of aging and long-term services. 17 - 2 -18 19 20 21 22 23 24 25 .203377.1

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
