18	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE
19	OF NEW MEXICO, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN,
20	that Joint Rule 1-1 be amended to read:
21	"JOINT SESSIONS (1-1)
22	<u>A.</u> Whenever the two houses of the legislature
23	meet in joint session, the proceedings shall be
24	entered upon the journal of each house. The
25	lieutenant governor or, in [his] <u>the lieutenant</u>

1	governor's absence, the president pro tempore
2	shall preside over the joint session and the
3	chief clerk of the house shall act as the clerk
4	thereof. A majority of the [elected] members
5	of each house shall constitute a quorum for the
6	transaction of business; provided, that upon
7	unanimous consent, the attendance roll calls of
8	each house for that legislative day may be
9	substituted for the roll call of the joint
10	session. No bill shall be considered, debated
11	or voted upon in a joint session.
12	B. No seating in the gallery during a joint
13	session shall be reserved. All gallery seating
14	during a joint session shall be open to the
15	public.".
