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16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
17	SECTION 1. A new section of the Lynn and Erin
18	Compassionate Use Act is enacted to read:
19	"[<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] LICENSED PRODUCERSPLANT POSSESSION
20	LIMITATIONFEE
21	A. On an annual basis and in accordance with
22	department rules, an applicant for licensure shall submit an
23	application for licensure or renewal of licensure. The
24	application shall include a production plan that specifies the
25	number of plants the applicant intends to possess during the
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1 upcoming fiscal year.

2	B. The department shall limit the number of plants
3	that a licensed producer, who is not a qualified patient
4	producing for the patient's own personal use, may possess to a
5	number that is equal to fifteen percent of qualified patients
6	statewide at the time the licensed producer, or applicant for
7	licensure, submits an application for licensure in accordance
8	with the provisions of Subsection A of this section.
9	C. The department shall assess a licensed producer:
10	(1) who is a qualified patient applying for a
11	license for personal production an annual license fee that
12	shall not exceed a total of thirty dollars (\$30.00); and
13	(2) that is any other type of licensed
14	producer an annual license fee that shall not exceed two
15	hundred dollars (\$200) per plant."
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
