## SENATE EXECUTIVE MESSAGE NO. 39

The Honorable Mary Kay Papen, President Pro Tempore and Members of the New Mexico State Senate State Capitol Building Santa Fe, New Mexico 87501

Honorable President Pro Tempore Papen and Members of the Senate:

Pursuant to the Constitution of the State of New Mexico, Article IV, Section 22, I hereby VETO and return SENATE BILL 148, as amended, enacted by the Fifty-Third Legislature, First Session, 2017.

This bill requires the Public Education Department to develop rules for the training of school employees for the care of students with diabetes. It also requires that at least one employee who receives the training to be present and available during school and all school-related activities in which a student with diabetes is participating—including trips, extended off-site excursions, extracurricular activities, and on buses.

While this legislation is well-intentioned, I have several concerns. First, this is an unfunded mandate and our schools cannot absorb the costs associated with training and staffing.

Second, thirty-two of our thirty-three counties are considered to be health care professional shortage areas, which will impact the implementation of this bill.

Third, the correct training for the school employees is not addressed, and a demonstration of competency is not required. Further, these employees are not required to be health care professionals, which means that lay persons may be administering oral drugs or injecting insulin.

Finally, despite being named in the bill, the New Mexico School Nurses Association was not consulted. This organization is vital to our schools and its input is critical to an initiative like this one.

For these reasons, I veto Senate Bill 148.
