SENATE FLOOR AMENDMENT number \_\_\_\_\_ to SENATE BILL 337

Amendment sponsored by Senator George K. Munoz

1. On page 2, between lines 16 and 17, insert the following new sections:

"SECTION 2. [NEW MATERIAL] FIREARMS ON STATE CAPITOL PREMISES PROHIBITED--LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL SERVICE DUTIES.--

A. The legislative council service shall, at each public entrance to the state capitol premises:

(1) post notices that state that it is unlawful to carry a firearm on state capitol premises, pursuant to Section 1 of this 2017 act; and

(2) install a device used to detect the presence of a firearm.

B. For the purposes of this section, "state capitol premises" means the state capitol building, the capitol north building and the interior corridor that connects the two buildings.

SECTION 3. Section 29-2-27 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1969, Chapter 125, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:

"29-2-27. SECURITY FOR THE GOVERNOR AND THE [LEGISLATURE] STATE CAPITOL PREMISES.--

A. The New Mexico state police shall:

(1) provide security and protection for the governor and [~~security and protection for~~] the governor's family. The extent and manner in which the security is provided shall be determined by

the governor and the chief of the New Mexico state police; and

(2) provide security and protection for the  
[legislature while it is in session] state capitol premises and  
shall be posted at each public entrance to the premises.

B. For the purposes of this section, "state capitol  
premises" means the state capitol building, the capitol north  
building and the interior corridor that connects the two  
buildings."
