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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
16	SECTION 1. [NEW MATERIAL] EQUAL ACCESS TO PUBLIC BABY
17	CHANGING FACILITIES
18	A. As used in this section:
19	(1) "baby changing facility" means a table or
20	other device suitable for changing the diaper of a child age
21	three or under;
22	(2) "division" means the construction
23	industries division of the regulation and licensing department;
24	(3) "public accommodation" means:
25	(a) an inn, hotel, motel or other place
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1	of lodging except for an establishment that is located within a
2	building that contains not more than five rooms for rent or
3	hire and that is actually occupied by the proprietor of such
4	establishment as a residence;
5	(b) a restaurant, bar or other
6	establishment serving food or drink;
7	(c) a motion picture house, theater,
8	concert hall, stadium or other place of exhibition or
9	entertainment;
10	(d) an auditorium, convention center,
11	lecture hall or other place of public gathering;
12	(e) a bakery, grocery store, clothing
13	store, shopping center or other sales or rental establishment;
14	(f) a laundromat, bank, barber shop,
15	beauty shop, travel service, funeral parlor, gas station,
16	office of an accountant or lawyer, pharmacy, insurance office,
17	professional office of a health care provider, hospital or
18	other service establishment;
19	(g) a terminal, depot or other station
20	used for public transportation;
21	(h) a museum, library, gallery or other
22	place of public display or collection;
23	(i) a park, zoo, amusement park or other
24	place of recreation;
25	(j) a nursery, elementary, secondary,
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undergraduate or postgraduate school or other place of education;

- (k) a daycare center, senior citizen center, homeless shelter, food bank, adoption agency or other social service center establishment; and
- (1) a gymnasium, health spa, bowling alley, golf course or other place of exercise or recreation; and
- (4) "substantial renovation" means a construction or renovation project with an estimated cost of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) or more that requires a building permit.
- B. No later than January 1, 2018, the division shall develop and adopt rules governing baby changing facilities for restrooms in a place of public accommodation.
- C. A place of public accommodation shall provide a baby changing facility in restrooms for men and in restrooms for women. This requirement applies only under the following circumstances:
- (1) when there is construction of a new restroom or a substantial renovation of a restroom; and
- (2) to the extent it may be implemented in compliance with local, state and federal laws regarding access for persons with disabilities and with existing fire, health and safety standards.

- (1) is not available or accessible for public use; or
- contains clear and conspicuous signage indicating where a restroom with a baby changing facility is located on the same floor of such place of public accommodation.
- This section shall not be construed to create a private right of action for failure to comply with the provisions of this section or rules adopted in accordance with this section.
- F. The division may assess a fine, not to exceed two hundred fifty dollars (\$250), for violation of the provisions of this section or rules adopted in accordance with this section. Fines shall be credited to the current school fund as provided in Article 12, Section 4 of the constitution of New Mexico.

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
