AN ACT

RELATING TO PRESIDENTIAL ELECTORS; REQUIRING ELECTORS WHO DO NOT VOTE FOR THE CANDIDATE OF THE POLITICAL PARTY THAT NOMINATED THEM TO BE DISQUALIFIED AND THE VACANCY FILLED BY GUBERNATORIAL APPOINTMENT; PRESCRIBING A PROCEDURE FOR FILLING VACANCIES; REPEALING SECTION 1-15-9 NMSA 1978 (BEING LAWS 1969, CHAPTER 240, SECTION 359).

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

**SECTION 1.** Section 1-15-7 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1969, Chapter 240, Section 357) is amended to read:

"1-15-7. PRESIDENTIAL ELECTORS--WHEN GOVERNOR FILLS VACANCY.--In the case of the death, ~~[or]~~ absence or disqualification of any presidential elector or failure to complete the number of presidential electors by noon of the day fixed by the laws of the United States for presidential

1 electors to cast their ballots, the governor shall fill any  
2 vacancy by appointment. In filling the vacancy, the governor  
3 shall appoint a [~~voter of the state~~] presidential elector from  
4 a list of names of voters of the state nominated by the state  
5 [~~chairman~~] chair of the same political party represented by the  
6 presidential elector whose death, [~~or~~] absence or  
7 disqualification caused the vacancy."

8 SECTION 2. Section 1-15-8 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1969,  
9 Chapter 240, Section 358, as amended) is amended to read:

10 "1-15-8. PRESIDENTIAL ELECTORS--ELECTORAL COLLEGE CASTING  
11 BALLOTS--CERTIFICATION OF RESULTS.--

12 A. The presidential electors of the state shall  
13 meet at noon in the office of the secretary of state on the day  
14 fixed by the laws of the United States for presidential  
15 electors to cast their ballots for president and vice president  
16 [~~and~~] of the United States.

17 B. The secretary of state shall provide each  
18 presidential elector with a presidential and vice presidential  
19 ballot. The presidential electors shall mark their ballots for  
20 the candidates of the political party that nominated them as  
21 presidential electors.

22 C. Each presidential elector shall present a  
23 completed ballot to the secretary of state, who shall examine  
24 each ballot and accept as cast each ballot marked by a  
25 presidential elector consistent with the candidate of the

1 political party that nominated the presidential elector. The  
2 secretary of state shall not accept and shall not count a  
3 ballot if the presidential elector has not marked the ballot or  
4 has marked the ballot for a candidate other than the candidate  
5 of the political party that nominated the presidential elector.

6 D. A presidential elector who refuses to present a  
7 ballot, who attempts to present an unmarked ballot or who  
8 attempts to present a ballot marked for a candidate other than  
9 the candidate of the political party that nominated the  
10 presidential elector is disqualified as a presidential elector  
11 and vacates the office of presidential elector.

12 E. The governor shall fill any vacancy by  
13 appointment in accordance with the procedure prescribed by  
14 Section 1-15-7 NMSA 1978. Any presidential elector appointed  
15 by the governor to fill a vacancy who fails or refuses to  
16 present a ballot marked for the candidate of the party that  
17 nominated the presidential elector shall be disqualified, the  
18 office deemed vacant and another presidential elector shall be  
19 appointed by the governor.

20 F. After all vacancies are filled, the presidential  
21 electors shall proceed [~~to vote by ballot for~~] with the  
22 election of the president and vice president of the United  
23 States and [~~to~~] shall certify the results of such election in  
24 accordance with the constitution and laws of the United States.

25 G. The presidential elector chosen as secretary

1 shall keep a journal of the proceedings and deposit the journal  
2 in the office of the secretary of state, where it shall be kept  
3 on file."

4 SECTION 3. REPEAL.--Section 1-15-9 NMSA 1978 (being Laws  
5 1969, Chapter 240, Section 359) is repealed.
