AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A WORKFORCE AND PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM FOR EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATORS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. --

- A. One million dollars (\$1,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the children, youth and families department for expenditure in fiscal year 2018 to fund an ongoing workforce and professional development program as follows:
- (1) three hundred eighty-eight thousand five hundred dollars (\$388,500) to fund retention incentives to increase the quality of early childhood education for children from birth until the age of kindergarten eligibility; and
 - (2) six hundred eleven thousand five hundred

dollars (\$611,500) to fund continuing education and professional development for early childhood educators who qualify under the children, youth and families department rules.

- В. The children, youth and families department shall contract for the implementation and management of the workforce and professional development program through a nonprofit entity or entities experienced in promoting quality early childhood education.
- C. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2018 shall revert to the general fund.
