21	SECTION 1. A new section of the Public School Code is

23	"[<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] TIMELY GRADUATION AND SUPPORT FOR STUDENTS
24	WHO EXPERIENCE DISRUPTION IN THE STUDENT'S EDUCATION
25	A. For purposes of this section, "a student who has

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experienced disruption in the student's education" means a student who experiences one or more changes in school or school district enrollment during a single school year as the result of:

5 (1) homelessness as defined in the federal
6 McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act;

(2) adjudication:

8 (a) as an abused or neglected child;
9 (b) as part of a family in need of
10 court-ordered services voluntary placement pursuant to the
11 Family Services Act; or

(c) as a delinquent; or

(3) placement in a mental health treatmentfacility or habilitation program for developmental disabilitiespursuant to the Children's Mental Health and DevelopmentalDisabilities Act who or placement in treatment foster care.

B. When a student who has experienced a disruption in the student's education transfers to a new public school or school district, the receiving school or school district shall communicate with the sending school district within two days of the student's enrollment. The sending school or school district shall provide the receiving school or school district with any requested records within two days of having received the receiving school's or school district's communication.

C. A student who has experienced a disruption in

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1 the student's education transferring to a new school as the 2 result of circumstances set forth in this section shall have: 3 (1) priority placement in classes that meet 4 state graduation requirements; and timely placement in elective classes that 5 (2) are comparable to those in which the student was enrolled at 6 7 the student's previous school or schools as soon as the school or school district receives verification from the student's 8 9 records. For a student who has experienced disruption in 10 D. the student's education at any time during the student's high 11 12 school enrollment, a school district and public schools shall 13 ensure: acceptance of the student's state 14 (1)graduation requirements for a diploma of excellence pursuant to 15 the Public School Code: 16 equal access to participation in sports 17 (2) and other extracurricular activities, career and technical 18 programs or other special programs for which the student 19 20 qualifies; timely assistance and advice from (3) 21 counselors to improve the student's college or career 22 readiness; and 23 that the student receives all special (4) 24 education services to which the student is entitled." 25 .205160.4

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
