10 AN ACT

11 RELATING TO ELECTRIC UTILITIES; AMENDING A SECTION OF THE  
12 RENEWABLE ENERGY ACT TO REQUIRE UTILITIES AND ELECTRIC  
13 COOPERATIVES TO PARTICIPATE IN SOLAR PROJECTS PLANNED BY LOCAL  
14 GOVERNMENTS, POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS OR STATE POST-SECONDARY  
15 EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS AND TO ACCEPT THE ENERGY GENERATED BY  
16 THOSE PROJECTS.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

19 SECTION 1. Section 62-16-7 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2004,  
20 Chapter 65, Section 7) is amended to read:

21 "62-16-7. COMMISSION--ADDITIONAL POWERS AND DUTIES.--The  
22 commission:

23 A. shall adopt rules regarding the renewable  
24 portfolio standard, including requiring utilities and electric  
25 cooperatives to participate in solar projects planned by local

1 governments, political subdivisions or state post-secondary  
2 educational institutions and to accept the energy generated by  
3 those projects, and including a provision for public utility  
4 records and reports;

5 B. may require that a public utility offer its  
6 retail customers a voluntary program for purchasing renewable  
7 energy that is in addition to energy provided by the public  
8 utility pursuant to the renewable portfolio standard, under  
9 rates and terms that are approved by the commission; and

10 C. may exempt from compliance with the renewable  
11 portfolio standard a public utility that has an all-  
12 requirements electric supply contract on July 1, 2004, and the  
13 contract would not reasonably permit it to procure renewable  
14 energy for purposes of meeting the renewable portfolio  
15 standard. When the electricity supply contract is amended or  
16 renegotiated, the commission may require that a renewable  
17 portfolio standard become applicable."
