AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC RECORDS; REQUIRING INVESTIGATION REPORTS TO BE PROVIDED TO THE PARENT OF A STUDENT INVOLVED IN AN INVESTIGATION WHEN MISCONDUCT HAS BEEN ALLEGED AGAINST A SCHOOL DISTRICT LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. A new section of the Inspection of Public Records Act is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] INVESTIGATION OF SCHOOL DISTRICT LAW
ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS--REPORT TO PARENT IF STUDENT INVOLVED.-The findings and disposition of an internal or external
investigation of a school district law enforcement officer's
misconduct while performing the officer's duties as a public
official shall be provided to a parent if a student was
involved in the alleged misconduct. The report shall include
