AN ACT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. A new section of the Interior Designers Act is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] PERMIT AUTHORITY. -- A licensed interior designer who signs, stamps or seals a plan, specification, report or document shall have the authority to submit the plan, specification, report or document to a county, municipal or state authority for the purpose of obtaining a requisite permit for an interior design project. A county, municipal or state authority shall not refuse to accept a plan, specification, .206841.1
