AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC SCHOOLS; PROVIDING THAT CHILDREN WHO ATTEND
PRE-KINDERGARTEN AT A CHARTER SCHOOL SHALL HAVE FIRST PRIORITY
TO ATTEND KINDERGARTEN AT THAT CHARTER SCHOOL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 22-8B-4.1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2000,
Chapter 82, Section 3) is amended to read:

"22-8B-4.1. CHARTER SCHOOLS' ENROLLMENT PROCEDURES.--

A. Start-up schools and conversion schools are
subject to the following enrollment procedures:

- (1) a start-up school may either enroll
students on a first-come, first-served basis or through a
lottery selection process if the total number of applicants
exceeds the number of spaces available at the start-up school;
