two hundred thirty thousand dollars (\$230,000) to plan, design, construct, equip and furnish improvements to the water system in Columbus in Luna county

two hundred sixteen thousand five hundred dollars (\$216,500) to plan, design, construct, purchase and equip a generator and enclosure on the campus of western New Mexico university in Silver City in Grant county

three million one hundred thousand dollars (\$3,100,000) to plan, design, construct, demolish, purchase, renovate, equip and install improvements, including asbestos abatement, to Harlan hall science building at western New Mexico university in Silver City in Grant county
