CAPITAL PROJECTS FOR SENATOR GEORGE K. MUNOZ

I request that the following be funded:

- to the aging and long-term services department

**TSE'LICHII/RED ROCK CHP SENIOR CENTER CONSTRUCT**

three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) to plan, design, construct, equip and furnish a senior center on the Tse'Lichii/Red Rock chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

- to the public education department

**UNM-GALLUP NAVCAR NATIVE LANGUAGE ROBOTICS EQUIP**

sixty-five thousand dollars (\$65,000) to purchase and construct native American voice-controlled autonomous robot equipment for in-school and after-school programs to engage youth in native language programs statewide

- to the Indian affairs department

**RAMAH CHP CHAPTER HOUSE & PLANNED COMMUNITY**

two million four hundred thousand dollars (\$2,400,000) to acquire easements and rights of way and to plan, design, construct and equip a chapter house and planned community, including infrastructure, housing and community and government service centers, in Section 21 of the Ramah chapter of the Navajo Nation in Cibola county

**RAMAH CHP LIVESTOCK TRAINING FACILITY CONSTRUCT/EQUIP**

one million two hundred thousand dollars (\$1,200,000) to design, construct, purchase, install, furnish and equip the interior of the chapter's livestock training facility, including furniture, equipment, information technology and related infrastructure, in the Ramah chapter of the Navajo Nation in Cibola county

### **RAMAH CHP SOLID WASTE TRANSFER STATION**

three hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000) to plan, design, purchase, construct, equip and install a solid waste transfer station, including a trash compactor dumpster, a trash bin and an operator building, in the Ramah chapter of the Navajo Nation in Cibola county

### **RAMAH CHP WELLS**

two million seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$2,750,000) to plan, design, drill, construct, equip and install water wells at the Ramah detention center and in Section 27 of the Ramah chapter of the Navajo Nation in Cibola county

### **RAMAH CHP WWATER SYSTEM CONSTRUCT**

one million seven hundred thousand dollars (\$1,700,000) to acquire land, easements and rights of way and to plan, design and construct a wastewater system, including sewer line and lined lagoon, in the Mountain View area of the Ramah chapter of the Navajo Nation in Cibola county

### **BAAHAALI CHP CHAPTER HOUSE IMPROVE**

three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) to plan, design, construct, equip and improve the chapter house in the Baahaali chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

### **BAAHAALI CHP POWERLINE EXTEND & WIRING**

three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) to plan, design, construct and equip power line extensions and house wiring in the Baahaali chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

### **BAAHAALI CHP SOLID WASTE CTR HEAVY EQUIP/TRASH BIN**

seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to purchase, equip and install heavy equipment and trash bins for the solid waste collection and recycling center in the Baahaali chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

### **CHICHILTAH CHP BATHRM ADD**

two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to plan, design, construct and equip bathroom additions, including fixtures and wiring, in the Chichiltah chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

### **CHICHILTAH CHP SEWER LAGOON**

five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) to plan, design, construct and improve a sewer lagoon in the Chichiltah chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to purchase and equip a vehicle for the Tse'Lichii/Red Rock chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

### THOREAU CHP VETERANS SERVICE CTR CONSTRUCT

three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) to plan, design and construct a veterans service center in the Thoreau chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

### TSE'II'AH'I' CHP HEADSTART BLDG CONSTRUCT

three million six hundred thousand dollars (\$3,600,000) to construct, equip and furnish a headstart facility in the Tse'ii'ahi' (Standing Rock) chapter of the Navajo Nation

### ASHIWI COLLEGE ROOF REPAIR ZUNI

two hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$275,000) to plan, design and construct roof repairs at Ashiwi college and career center in the Pueblo of Zuni in McKinley county

### ZUNI CDA WWATER LAGOON CONSTRUCT

six hundred fifty-one thousand nine hundred eight dollars (\$651,908) to plan, design and construct a wastewater lagoon for the commercial development area in the Pueblo of Zuni in McKinley county

### ZUNI WATER SYSTEM GENERATOR PURCH & EQUIP

three hundred fifty-two thousand dollars (\$352,000) to plan, design, construct, purchase and equip a generator, including concrete pad and stand, to power the main water well in the Pueblo of Zuni in McKinley county

one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000) to plan, design and construct phase 1 of Sky City roads project in the Manuelito chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

one hundred fourteen thousand dollars (\$114,000) to plan, design and construct improvements to Hunters Point road in the Tsayatoh chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county
