7	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
8	SECTION 1. CARLSBAD BRINE WELL REMEDIATION ADVISORY
9	AUTHORITYCREATEDMEMBERSHIPADMINISTRATION OF THE
10	CARLSBAD BRINE WELL REMEDIATION
11	A. The "Carlsbad brine well remediation advisory
12	authority" is created. The authority is a governmental
13	entity of the state. The membership of the board of
14	directors of the authority shall consist of the following
15	eight members:
16	(1) the mayor of the city of Carlsbad or the
17	mayor's designee, who shall serve as chair of the board;
18	(2) the chair of the Eddy county board of
19	county commissioners or the chair's designee;
20	(3) the secretary of energy, minerals and
21	natural resources or the secretary's designee;
22	(4) the secretary of environment or the
23	secretary's designee;
24	(5) the secretary of transportation or the
25	secretary's designee:

1	(6) the manager of the Carlsbad irrigation
2	district or the manager's designee;
3	(7) the state engineer or the state
4	engineer's designee; and
5	(8) the attorney general or the attorney
6	general's designee.
7	B. The advisory authority:
8	(1) shall recommend policy for and advise
9	the oil conservation division of the energy, minerals and
10	natural resources department on the remediation of the
11	Carlsbad brine well located at: Unit Letter M (SW/4 of the
12	SW/4) in Section 17, Township 22 South, Range 27 East, NMPM;
13	Eddy County, New Mexico; and
14	(2) is granted all powers necessary and
15	appropriate to provide advice to the division for a revenue
16	source dedicated to the Carlsbad brine well remediation fund.
17	C. Nothing in this section shall be construed as
18	a waiver or alteration of the immunity from liability granted
19	pursuant to the Tort Claims Act or as a waiver of any other
20	immunity or privilege under law.
21	SECTION 2. CARLSBAD BRINE WELL REMEDIATION FUND
22	CREATEDPURPOSECONDITIONS
23	A. There is created the "Carlsbad brine well
24	remediation fund". The energy, minerals and natural

resources department shall administer the fund. The fund

- B. Money in the fund may consist of federal grants, appropriations, donations, earnings from investment of the fund and other revenue that from time to time may accrue to the fund from other sources for remediation of the Carlsbad brine well.
- C. Money in the fund shall be subject to appropriation by the legislature and shall not revert at the end of any fiscal year.
- D. Money in the fund shall be disbursed on warrants signed by the secretary of finance and administration pursuant to vouchers signed by the secretary of energy, minerals and natural resources or the secretary's authorized representative.
- SECTION 3. TERMINATION OF AGENCY LIFE--DELAYED

  REPEAL.--The Carlsbad brine well remediation advisory

  authority is terminated on July 1, 2029 pursuant to the

  Sunset Act. The advisory authority shall continue to operate

  according to the provisions of this act until July 1, 2030.

  Effective July 1, 2030, this act is repealed.
- SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 2017.
