Section 37-1-30 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1993, 9 Chapter 136, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read: 10 "37-1-30. ACTION FOR DAMAGES DUE TO CHILDHOOD SEXUAL ABUSE--LIMITATION ON ACTIONS.--11 12 A. An action for damages based on personal injury 13 caused by childhood sexual abuse shall be commenced by a 14 person before the latest of the following dates: 15 (1) the first instant of the person's 16 twenty-fourth birthday; or 17 (2) three years from the date that a person 18 first disclosed the person's childhood sexual abuse to a 19 licensed medical or mental health care provider in the 20 context of receiving health care from the provider. 21 B. As used in this section, "childhood sexual 22 abuse" means conduct that, if prosecuted in a criminal 23 matter, would constitute a violation of: 24 Section 30-9-11 NMSA 1978, regarding (1) 25 criminal sexual penetration of a minor;

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1	(2) Section 30-9-13 NMSA 1978, regarding	
2	criminal sexual contact of a minor; or	
3	(3) the Sexual Exploitation of Children Act.	
4	C. The provisions of Section 37-1-8 NMSA 1978 and	
5	any statutes of limitation therein shall not apply to causes	
6	of action for childhood sexual abuse."	
7	SECTION 2. EMERGENCYIt is necessary for the public	
8	peace, health and safety that this act take effect	
9	immediately	
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
