SECTION 1. DEVELOPMENT OF POLICIES TO DECREASE INSTITUTIONAL RACISM--DEFINITION.--

- A. Each state agency and any entity receiving state funding shall develop and implement policies to decrease institutional racism and provide effective, equitable and fair service to the state's diverse communities. No later than July 31 of each year, state agencies shall report to the legislature their findings, action plans, policies and practices for addressing institutional racism.
- B. In fulfilling the requirements of Subsection A of this section, state agencies shall:
- (1) assess their anti-institutional racism policies in hiring, promotion, retention, pay equity, community engagement and workplace participation;
- (2) create a data infrastructure that allows for tracking progress toward ending institutional racism;
