BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO: SECTION 1. RELEASE OF INCARCERATED WOMEN WHO ARE PREGNANT OR LACTATING .--

The court shall consider an incarcerated 8 Α. 9 woman's pregnancy and lactation status when determining 10 whether she is eligible for release or bond and in the 11 computation of good time credit. At the court's discretion, 12 an incarcerated woman who is due to give birth may be granted 13 release from incarceration in a prison or jail prior to the 14 presumptive birth date of her child and for up to eighteen 15 months after the birth of her child, or for as long as 16 medically indicated, unless the court finds that public 17 safety would not be best served by the woman's release. A 18 presumption shall be made in favor of release for a woman who 19 is pregnant or lactating. For the duration of her release, a 20 woman released pursuant to this section shall be placed on 21 the least restrictive conditions of release necessary to 22 ensure her return to custody. After the period of release, 23 the woman shall serve any remaining portion of her sentence. 24
