PROCLAIMING MARCH 3, 2017 AS "SPEECH AND DEBATE EDUCATION DAY" IN THE SENATE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that in recognition of the substantial contribution speech and debate experience makes to students' educations and lives, March 3, 2017 be proclaimed "speech and debate education day" in the senate; and
