5	WHEREAS, decades ago, the introduction of memorials was	
6	a rare occurrence, carrying much significance and	
7	memorializing prestigious members of New Mexico communities;

9	WHEREAS, over the past twenty years, the number of	
10	memorials introduced has dramatically increased; and	
11	WHEREAS, in 1997, just fifteen senate memorials were	
12	introduced; and	
13	WHEREAS, in 2017, with several days remaining in the	
14	regular session, more than one hundred fifty-five senate	
15	memorials have been introduced; and	
16	WHEREAS, every day of a session, hours are spent	
17	discussing and debating memorials that have no legal effect	
18	while pressing legislative issues go unaddressed; and	
19	WHEREAS, many state resources, including time, money	
20	and personnel, are expended in preparing, printing,	
21	introducing, discussing and debating memorials in committee	
22	and on the floor and, if they pass, which it seems nearly all	
23	of them do, implementing the requested action; and	
24	WHEREAS, while many introduced memorials suggest	
25	implementation of a worthy study, a solution to a pressing	SM 146 Page 1

1	problem or the designation of a day worth recognizing, the
2	full costs to taxpayers of preparing and implementing
3	memorials are not known;
