SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 24 amends the Infrastructure Development Zone Act to provide for broadband infrastructure development by a local government. It adjusts references in the definitions to New Mexico statute instead of referring to the Infrastructure Development Zone Act. Additionally, the "Infrastructure Development Zone" is added to the same definition. Lastly, in the definition of "services," or section J subsection 12, "and any broadband technology infrastructure" is added to the end of the definition.
