SUMMARY

Synopsis of Memorial:

Senate Memorial 121 asks the state's Congressional delegation to assure that federal facilities in New Mexico implement hiring practices that result in parity for Hispanics and other minorities in the state. The background given in the memorial suggests a long history of discussions between New Mexico's Congressional delegation and federal representatives on this issue, but the last contact referred to was in 1998. The memorial does not indicate the success of previous efforts, but suggests that further efforts now may yield positive effects.

WHAT WILL BE THE CONSEQUENCES OF NOT ENACTING THIS BILL

There would be no memorial presentation to New Mexico's Congressional delegation on the importance of minority representation among the workforces at the state's federal institutions.
