

HOUSE JOINT MEMORIAL 16

INTRODUCED BY

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A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE NEW MEXICO LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL TO CONVENE A TASK FORCE TO REVIEW AND STUDY THE LEGISLATIVE PROCESS IN NEW MEXICO.

WHEREAS, the legislative power is vested by Article 4 of the constitution of New Mexico in a senate and house of representatives, designated as the legislature of the state of New Mexico; and

WHEREAS, the house of representatives is composed of seventy members, and the senate is composed of forty-two members; and

WHEREAS, the legislature is responsible for crafting and shaping the laws impacting the New Mexicans it serves; and

WHEREAS, the legislature is a coequal branch of government, essential to an effective system of checks and

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1 balances with the executive and judicial branches of
2 government; and

3 WHEREAS, while the legislature is constantly seeking ways
4 to improve policies that affect all aspects of state
5 government, it must also continue to seek possible improvements
6 to help it conduct its work and perform its duties more
7 effectively; and

8 WHEREAS, in 2002, the New Mexico legislative council
9 conducted a study of the roles, responsibilities, functions,
10 structure and organization of the legislative committee
11 process; and

12 WHEREAS, in 2007, the legislative structure and process
13 study task force was formed to develop recommendations to more
14 effectively perform the policymaking and oversight duties of
15 the legislature; and

16 WHEREAS, it is important to build upon the work resulting
17 from these previous studies and to consider new proposals to
18 innovate the legislative process;

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE
20 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the New Mexico legislative council be
21 requested to convene a task force to review and study the
22 legislative process in New Mexico; and

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the New Mexico legislative
24 council be requested to appoint members from the house of
25 representatives and the senate and public members to the task

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1 force; and

2 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force be requested to
3 include in its study consideration of the length of legislative
4 sessions, compensation of legislative members, investigation of
5 ethics complaints, legislative efficiency and other topics
6 affecting the work of the legislature; and

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force be requested to
8 issue a report of its findings and recommendations by December
9 31, 2017; and

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be
11 transmitted to the co-chairs of the New Mexico legislative
12 council and the director of the legislative council service.
