A MEMORIAL

EXPRESSING SUPPORT OF INITIATIVES TO BUILD A NEW OIL REFINERY
IN MCKINLEY COUNTY.

WHEREAS, New Mexico is rich in natural resource deposits,
including oil, and a significant portion of those resources are
in McKinley county; and

WHEREAS, the state has an opportunity to take advantage of
untapped natural resources by exploring safe, reliable mineral
production; and

WHEREAS, United States Representative Steve Pearce
addressed a joint session of the state legislature on February
9, 2017; and

WHEREAS, in his address, Representative Pearce stated that
he had approached the Trump administration about the idea of
building a new oil refinery in New Mexico; and

1 WHEREAS, a revival of the oil and gas industry in New
2 Mexico could help raise tax revenues in the state's suffering
3 economic climate; and

4 WHEREAS, Representative Pearce stated that a new oil
5 refinery would inject high-paying jobs into New Mexico's
6 economy; and

7 WHEREAS, because of its natural resources wealth, McKinley
8 county is ideally situated as a prime location for a new oil
9 refinery;

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE
11 OF NEW MEXICO that it support initiatives to build a new oil
12 refinery in McKinley county; and

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that efforts by New Mexico's
14 congressional delegation to foster the oil and gas industry in
15 New Mexico be supported; and

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the continuing efforts to
17 support the oil and gas industry and to improve New Mexico's
18 economic climate be encouraged; and

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be
20 transmitted to members of the New Mexico congressional
21 delegation.
