AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH CARE; ENACTING A NEW SECTION OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH ACT TO ESTABLISH CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS FOR RENAL DIALYSIS FACILITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. A new section of the Public Health Act is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] RENAL DIALYSIS FACILITY--COUNSELING
REQUIREMENT.--The secretary of health shall require any
facility that provides renal dialysis in an inpatient or
ambulatory setting to provide to patients who receive renal
dialysis in that facility counseling on current evidence-based
practices, including kidney transplant, that may maximize the
patient's health outcomes."

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
