14	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONOne million five hundred
15	thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) is appropriated from the public
16	project revolving fund to the local government planning fund
17	administered by the New Mexico finance authority for
18	expenditure in fiscal year 2019 and subsequent fiscal years to
19	make grants to qualified entities to evaluate and estimate the
20	costs of implementing the most feasible alternatives for
21	infrastructure, water or wastewater public projects or to
22	develop water conservation plans, long-term master plans,
23	economic development plans or energy audits and to pay the
24	administrative costs of the local government planning program.
