11 RELATING TO CAPITAL OUTLAY FUNDING; REQUIRING PUBLICATION OF
12 CAPITAL OUTLAY PROJECT AUTHORIZATIONS, APPROPRIATIONS AND
13 VETOES; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

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15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

16 SECTION 1. [NEW MATERIAL] CAPITAL OUTLAY PROJECT
17 FUNDING--PUBLICATION.--

18 A. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 2-3-13
19 NMSA 1978 to the contrary, the legislative council service
20 shall, within thirty days after the adjournment of a
21 legislative session in which the legislature passes a capital
22 outlay bill and after either the governor acts on the bill or
23 the deadline for that action passes, publish on the New Mexico
24 legislature website a searchable listing, as user-friendly as
25 is practicable to design, of all the projects in the bill that

1 specifies:

2 (1) those authorized for funding and those
3 receiving an appropriation and, for each:

4 (a) the name of each person, whether a
5 legislator or the governor, whose request results in the
6 authorization or appropriation; and

7 (b) the portion of funding for the
8 project attributed to each of those people; and

9 (2) those vetoed and, for each:

10 (a) the name of each person, whether a
11 legislator or the governor, whose request would result in the
12 project's authorization for funding or receipt of an
13 appropriation if not vetoed; and

14 (b) the portion of funding for the
15 project that, if not vetoed, would be attributed to each of
16 those people.

17 B. The legislative council service shall provide a
18 paper copy of the web-based publication required by Subsection
19 A of this section upon request.

20 SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public
21 peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
