11 RELATING TO PUBLIC EDUCATION; AMENDING THE PUBLIC SCHOOL CODE
12 TO ESTABLISH A MINIMUM SALARY FOR CERTAIN SCHOOL DISTRICT
13 PERSONNEL.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

16 SECTION 1. Section 22-10A-39 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1994,
17 Chapter 95, Section 1) is amended to read:

18 "22-10A-39. [~~NONCERTIFIED~~] CERTAIN SCHOOL PERSONNEL--
19 SALARIES.--Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 50-4-22
20 NMSA 1978, a [~~local~~] school district or a charter school shall
21 pay a [~~minimum~~] wage rate of [~~six dollars (\$6.00)~~] not less
22 than sixteen dollars (\$16.00) per hour to all school district
23 cafeteria staff and school bus drivers, whether under contract
24 or employment; and all noncertified school personnel and
25 licensed educational assistants; provided that, beginning with

1 fiscal year 2021 and in each subsequent fiscal year, that
2 amount shall be adjusted by the percentage change between the
3 penultimate calendar year and the immediately preceding
4 calendar year of the consumer price index for the United
5 States, all items, as published by the United States department
6 of labor."

7 SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the
8 provisions of this act is July 1, 2019.
