15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
16	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION
17	A. One hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) is
18	appropriated from the general fund to the children, youth and
19	families department for expenditure in fiscal year 2019 to fund
20	an ongoing workforce and professional development program to
21	increase the quality of early childhood education for children
22	from birth to the age of eligibility for kindergarten.
23	Participants in the ongoing workforce and professional
24	development program shall be early childhood educators who
25	qualify under children, youth and families department rules.
