I request that the following be funded:

two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to plan, design and construct an addition to the senior center in the Red Valley chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

TWO GREY HILLS CHP SENIOR CENTER ADDITION

one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) to plan, design and construct an addition and improvements to the senior center, including improvements to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, at the Two Grey Hills chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

TWO GREY HILLS CHP SENIOR CENTER ADDITION

one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) to plan, design and construct an addition and improvements to the senior center, including improvements to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, at the Two Grey Hills chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

MUSEUM OF INDIAN ARTS & CULTURE AMPHITHEATER REN

two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) to plan, design, construct and equip renovations and repairs to an amphitheater, including shade structures, walkways, bancos, ramadas, horno ovens and a gate, at the museum of Indian arts and culture in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county

two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) to plan, design, construct, purchase and install bathroom additions in the Tooh Haltsooi chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

TOOH HALTSOOI CHP NEW W FOOTHILLS POWER LINE

six hundred four thousand six hundred seventy dollars (\$604,670) to plan, design and construct the new west foothills power line extensions in the Tooh Haltsooi chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

BECLABITO CHP CEMETERY FENCE

fifty-five thousand dollars (\$55,000) to plan, design and construct a fence at the community cemetery in the vicinity of the Beclabito chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

BECLABITO CHP HELIPAD

three hundred fifteen thousand dollars (\$315,000) to plan, design and construct a helipad in the Beclabito chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

SAN JUAN CHP PARKING LOT LIGHTS

six hundred twenty-four thousand eight hundred fifty-seven dollars (\$624,857) to plan, design, construct and equip improvements to a multipurpose building parking lot, including lighting and landscaping, in the San Juan chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) to plan, design, construct and renovate the roof on the multipurpose building in the Nenahnezad chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

NEWCOMB CHP HELIPORT CONSTRUCT

three hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$375,000) to plan, design and construct a heliport in the Newcomb chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

RED VALLEY CHP BATHROOMS/WATER

two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to plan, design and construct water lines and bathroom additions in the Red Valley chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

RED VALLEY CHP POWER LINE EXTENSION

two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to plan, design and construct power line extensions in the Red Valley chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

RED VALLEY CHP TRANSFER STATION

two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to design and construct a transfer station in the Red Valley chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

SANOSTEE CHP POWER LINE EXTENSION

one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) to plan, design and construct a power line extension in the Sanostee chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

TSE'DAA'KAAN CHP COMMUNITY SVC CENTER

two hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$225,000) to plan, design and construct a community service center in the Tse'Daa'Kaan chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to construct power line extensions in the Tse'Daa'Kaan chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

three million six hundred thousand dollars (\$3,600,000) to plan, design and construct phase 1 improvements to Navajo route 5113 in the Beclabito chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

one million seven hundred ninety-one thousand dollars (\$1,791,000) to plan, design and construct improvements to a school bus route on Navajo route 366 in the San Juan chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

INDIAN SERVICE RTE 57 GADII'AH/TO'KOI CHP IMPROVE

two hundred ten thousand four hundred forty-six dollars (\$210,446) to plan, design and construct road and drainage improvements to Indian service route 57 in the Gadii'ahi/To'Koi chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

SAN JUAN CHP BRIDGE

eleven million two hundred thousand dollars (\$11,200,000) to plan, design and construct a bridge over the San Juan river from the San Juan chapter of the Navajo Nation to United States highway 64 in San Juan county

SHIPROCK CHP STREETLIGHTS

one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) to purchase and install streetlight poles and streetlights for streets, parking lots and parks in Shiprock and the Shiprock chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

NAVAJO ROUTE 36 & NM HWY 371 IMPROVE

eight million one hundred thousand dollars (\$8,100,000) to plan, design and construct road and intersection improvements, including traffic lights, guard rails, signage, culverts and cattleguards, to Navajo route 36 and the intersection of Navajo route 36 and New Mexico highway 371 in the Upper Fruitland chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) to plan, design and construct a faculty housing complex for Navajo technical university in Crownpoint in McKinley county

sixty-six thousand five hundred seventy-five dollars (\$66,575) to purchase educational robotics equipment for elementary through high school students and teachers for use in robotic design and related coding curricula for math and science classes, including a Native American voice-controlled autonomous robot and an innovation kit, for eastern New Mexico university programs serving school districts in Bernalillo, Cibola, Lincoln, McKinley, San Juan, Sandoval, Santa Fe, Socorro, Rio Arriba and Taos counties

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
