A MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE LEGISLATIVE EDUCATION STUDY COMMITTEE TO CREATE A TASK FORCE TO STUDY THE CREATION OF AN INTERAGENCY SAFETY NET FOR MALTREATED CHILDREN.

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WHEREAS, the physical and emotional well-being and safety of children in New Mexico are of utmost importance; and

9 WHEREAS, tragic events in recent years have shed light
10 on how the maltreatment of children can escalate quickly
11 without the knowledge of concerned individuals, agency staff
12 and school staff; and

WHEREAS, children who have been maltreated and who stop attending school, whether a public, private or home school, are particularly vulnerable to falling through the cracks; and

WHEREAS, the state is dedicated to mobilizing all agencies and community organizations that are tasked with protecting the safety and security of children to help prevent such tragedies; and

WHEREAS, communication and collaboration among all
appropriate agencies and community organizations are
essential to protecting New Mexico's children;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OFREPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the

1 legislative education study committee be requested to create 2 a task force to study the measures necessary to create an 3 interagency safety net for maltreated children who are vulnerable to falling through the cracks and to seek 4 5 participation on the task force from at least one 6 representative from each of the following entities: the public education department; 7 Α. Β. the human services department; 8 C. the protective services division of the 9 10 children, youth and families department; and D. any other entities or individuals deemed 11 appropriate by the legislative education study committee; and 12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force publish its 13 findings and recommendations in a report, provide two copies 14 15 of the report to the legislative council service library and publish the report on the legislative education study 16 committee website; and 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be 18 transmitted to the chair of the legislative education study 19 20 committee; the secretary of public education; the secretary of human services; the secretary of children, youth and families; 21 the public education department for distribution to all 22 department offices and organizations mentioned in this 23 memorial; and others the public education department believes 24
