SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 86 amends Section 66-3-424.24 to provide that a parent, spouse, child or sibling of a service member killed in an armed conflict is eligible for a gold star family license plate.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The bill provides that an additional fee of \$10 will be collected for the original issuance of the special plate. The fees will be kept by the department to defray the cost of making and issuing the special plate.

ADMINISTRATIVE IMPLICATIONS

Implementation of this bill will have a low impact on the Information Technology Division and will take about four weeks to implement.
