WHEREAS, Aroonsri Khamsamran, the official producer of *Mud* (*Hashtł'ishnii*), is from Taos, New Mexico, and is a graduate of the interdisciplinary film and digital media school at the university of New Mexico; and

WHEREAS, two members of the cast of *Mud (Hashtł'ishnii)*,
Trini King and Forrest Goodluck, are from house district 4 and
senate district 3, and Forrest is also a screen actor's guild
member; and
