A MEMORIAL

DECLARING FEBRUARY 10, 2018 AS "NEW MEXICO PUBLIC EDUCATOR APPRECIATION DAY" AT THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

WHEREAS, public educators are vital and integral parts of New Mexico's education system throughout the state in early education centers, eighty-nine diverse school districts and institutions of higher learning; and

WHEREAS, learning is a continuum from birth through career, each level building upon prior learning, and educators work to embrace their students' cultural, linguistic and familial knowledge to create a truly enriching educational experience; and

WHEREAS, early education professionals work with New Mexico's youngest learners to lay a solid foundation for future learning and cultivate young minds in an effort to promote

14 role they play within New Mexico's education system at all
15 levels and work hard to serve all students; and

16 WHEREAS, New Mexico's public higher education institutions
17 continue to build upon the educational foundation that students
18 received in high school and provide students with essential
19 skills and knowledge that enhance personal growth, economic
20 opportunity and civic engagement; and

21 WHEREAS, faculty at New Mexico's public colleges and
22 universities conduct ground-breaking research that has led to
23 important contributions to the economic growth and social
24 welfare of the state; and

25 WHEREAS, New Mexico's public educators are, as a whole,
