BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the wellness education task force be requested to study possible legislative changes to existing statutes pertaining to the funding of school district wellness policies; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the wellness education task force be composed of representatives of the office of the governor, the public education department, the New Mexico school boards association and the legislative education study .209631.1 -2-
