A MEMORIAL

DECLARING FEBRUARY 10, 2018 "NEW MEXICO ASSOCIATION OF STUDENT COUNCILS DAY" IN THE SENATE.

WHEREAS, established in 1950, the New Mexico association of student councils was founded by a group of educators who wanted to create an organization for student leaders to encourage practice of the democratic process, citizenship and service while fostering an exchange of ideas and problem-solving strategies in New Mexico schools; and

WHEREAS, student councils follow the principles for which the United States was founded and focus on active citizen participation; and

WHEREAS, many members of the New Mexico legislature began their public service careers as members of student councils; and

19 people from across the state and nation; and

20          WHEREAS, youth across the country and New Mexico want to  
21 play an active role in their futures; and

22          WHEREAS, active engagement is critical to democracy, and  
23 the United States of America's founding fathers were the model

6 sponsors have come together to support the sixty-eighth New  
7 Mexico association of student councils conference; and

8 WHEREAS, solutions to preserve New Mexico's rich  
9 traditions for future generations can be implemented through  
10 dedicated student engagement on student councils;

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE  
12 OF NEW MEXICO that February 10, 2018 be declared "New Mexico  
13 Association of Student Councils Day" in the senate; and

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be
