12 TRANSMISSION SUBMISSION AND STORAGE OF PUBLIC COMMENTS FOR A

15 WHEREAS, Legislative Joint Rule 8-1 provides for the
16 adoption, amendment or repeal of joint rules by concurrent
17 resolution approved by two-thirds of the membership of each
18 house;

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, THE HOUSE OF
20 REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, that the following new
21 proposed Joint Rule 13-1 be adopted to read:
