AN ACT

RELATING TO TIME; EXEMPTING NEW MEXICO FROM THE FEDERAL LAW
REQUIRING THE OBSERVANCE OF HSEIC → ~~DAYLIGHT-SAVING~~ ← HSEIC
HSEIC → DAYLIGHT SAVING ← HSEIC TIME.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. [NEW MATERIAL] FINDINGS.--The legislature
finds that:

A. HSEIC → ~~the standard time of~~ ← HSEIC the

B. federal law requires the advancement of mountain standard time by one hour HSEIC→for←HSEIC HSEIC→during←HSEIC a portion of each year, a period commonly known as HSEIC→"daylight-saving←HSEIC HSEIC→daylight saving←HSEIC time"; and

C. HSEIC→that subsection←HSEIC HSEIC→federal law←HSEIC also allows a state that lies entirely within HSEIC→the mountain standard←HSEIC HSEIC→one←HSEIC time zone to exempt itself by law from the requirement to advance time for daylight saving if the HSEIC→law←HSEIC HSEIC→exemption←HSEIC applies to the entire state.

SECTION 2. [NEW MATERIAL] MOUNTAIN STANDARD TIME--NO ADVANCEMENT FOR DAYLIGHT SAVING.--Effective January 1, 2020, the entire state of New Mexico:

A. HSEIC→exempts itself←HSEIC HSEIC→shall be exempted←HSEIC from HSEIC→the←HSEIC federal law that requires advancing time for daylight saving; and

B. shall throughout the year observe mountain standard time without the advancement of time for daylight saving.
