AN ACT

RELATING TO FAMILIES; PROVIDING FOR FREE ADMISSION TO STATE-OWNED MUSEUMS AND STATE PARKS FOR FOSTER FAMILIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. [NEW MATERIAL] FOSTER FAMILIES--FREE ADMISSION TO MUSEUMS AND STATE PARKS.--Foster parents and children in the custody of foster parents Hf1→who are residents of the state←Hf1 shall be provided free admission to state-owned museums and state parks SIAC→Hf1→.←Hf1 Hf1→; provided that eligibility for free admission shall be contingent upon demonstration of proof of identity, residency and status as a
