RELATING TO PUBLIC HOLIDAYS; PROVIDING FOR OBSERVANCE ~~Hf1~~→**AT**
THE LEGISLATURE←~~Hf1~~ OF GUADALUPE HIDALGO TREATY DAY ON A MONDAY
IN YEARS THAT FEBRUARY 2 FALLS ON A SATURDAY OR SUNDAY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 12-5-10 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1997, Chapter 77, Section 1) is amended to read:

"12-5-10. GUADALUPE HIDALGO TREATY DAY.--February 2 of each year shall be set apart and known as "Guadalupe Hidalgo treaty day" in recognition and commemoration of the day in 1848
