RELATING TO JUDICIAL EDUCATION; INCLUDING TRIBAL JUDGES IN THE JUDGES EDUCATED BY THE JUDICIAL EDUCATION CENTER SJC→; **REMOVING A REQUIREMENT FOR TRAINING AND INSTRUCTION ON THE DISPOSITION OF DRIVING WHILE UNDER THE INFLUENCE CASES**←SJC.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 34-13-2 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1993, Chapter 273, Section 2) is amended to read:

"34-13-2. JUDICIAL EDUCATION CENTER CREATED--PURPOSE.--
